Counties began collecting and submitting Birth, Marriage and Death (BMD) data on the dates indicated in this chart. There were several counties or townships which were slow to respond and some kept the information even earlier. The jurisdictional approach, of course, is to check with the local governments of your ancestors to be quite certain.
